POSITION:

FISHERIES TECHNICIAN COLLEGE INTERN

Two (2) Non-exempt, Year-Round Student position
Hours as needed and in accordance with course schedule
(Dependent on Grant Funding)

LOCATION:

KBIC Natural Resources Department
Pequaming, Michigan

SUPERVISORY CONTROL:

Hatchery/Nursery Manager

SALARY:

Grade 4 (starting wage = \$16.47/hour)

Note: This position has been classified as 90% tax exempt for qualified KBIC tribal members under Internal Revenue Code §7873 – Tax Exemption for Income Derived from Treaty Fishing Rights-Related Activities.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must have a High School Diploma or GED and be at least 18 years of age.
- Must be a college-level student currently attending a college/university full or part-time.
- Must maintain good academic standing throughout employment (must provide copies of grades/class transcripts on a quarterly basis as documentation of academic standing).
- Must have worked with the KBIC Natural Resources Department at least one season/summer preferred.
- Must possess a valid, unrestricted driver's license, a good driving record, and be insurable to operate fleet vehicles. Must be willing to travel as necessary.
- Must be in good physical condition, able to perform physically strenuous duties, and shall be able to regularly lift and carry 50 pounds unassisted.
- Must possess good communication skills and legible handwriting.
- Must be willing to conduct fieldwork in a variety of environmental conditions.
- Must be familiar with computer software (Microsoft Word, Excel). Experience with GIS and/or GPS preferred.
- Must be able to obtain a satisfactory clearance in accordance with the Indian Child Protection and Family Violence Prevention Act Background Investigation Policy.
- Employment is contingent upon the satisfactory result of a Security Background Check, pre-employment drug testing, and pre-employment physical.

INDIAN PREFERENCE: Preference will be given to qualified individuals of American Indian descent.

VETERAN PREFERENCE: Preference will also be given to Veterans who do not have bad conduct or dishonorable discharges (need DD214)

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Complete relative training for the position as directed and when available that may include: fishery techniques, fish health management, hatchery techniques, etc.
2. Assist program staff in collecting relative fish, plant, wildlife, and environmental data, including the mapping and surveying of habitat and tying sampling nets.
3. Assist program staff in the collation and entry of data. Perform data entry into a computer.
4. Assist program staff in the operation and maintenance of fish hatchery including feeding fish, cleaning tanks, fin clipping, marking hatchery fish with federally approved chemicals for anesthetizing, fish stocking in area lakes and streams, and sampling fish, spawning fish, egg and fry care, data recording, tours, and cold water recirculating system and walleye ponds.
5. Responsible for assisting in the maintenance and repair of NRD equipment.
6. Shall be required to work in inclement weather and a variety of environmental conditions.
7. Assist staff with providing Public Outreach assistance (i.e. various departmental functions, including the Annual KBNRD Environmental Fair and Kids Fishing Derby).
8. Shall report daily to supervisor, complete work as assigned and be required to complete and submit various reports and summaries including work logs, data collection, and monthly reports.
9. Perform other duties as assigned by the Supervisor.
