Student Sovereign Fund Regulations

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Must be an enrolled member of the Keweenaw Bay Indian Community.
2. Must be enrolled in a one-year certificate, associate, bachelor, master, or doctoral program at an accredited college or university.
3. Maintain a minimum 2.0 grade point average (cumulative).
4. One probationary semester will be allowed with funding reduced by one-half the amount eligible, not to exceed \$400.00.
5. Dually enrolled students must submit paperwork from each school to be funded separately.
6. Dually enrolled students will not be funded more than one full-time and one half-time status per semester. Must be in good standing at both institutions.
7. Maintain enrollment status as funded:
 - Full-time (12 Credits) \$800.00
 - Three-quarter-time (9-11 Credits) \$600.00
 - Half-time (6-8 Credits) \$400.00
 - Less-than-half-time (2-5 Credits) \$200.00
